Ann Lucille Davis, 82, of Anderson, IN, passed away on Sunday evening January 1, 2023 at Bethany Pointe Health Memory Care after an extended illness.

Ann was born at home in Bridgeport, IL on January 17, 1940, to Floyd and Eleanor (nee: Reel) Sprinkle. Ann often reminisced about her travels with her parents, with trips to many of the landmarks all around the country. She was a musician playing clarinet in high school band and piano for her church. Ann was an active AHS band parent using her sewing skills repairing many uniforms and chaperoning while her daughters were in band. She continued her love of music being an avid fan of Drum Corps and attending many competitions. She also loved Broadway Musicals.

Ann was an accomplished quilter and created countless quilts for friends and family. She was a member of the Red Bud Quilt Guild for many years.

Preceding Ann in death were her parents and husband.
