



## Arthur Bender Jr.

May 11, 1912 - January 25, 2003

Anderson - Arthur Bender, Jr., 90, Anderson, died January 25, 2003 at Bethany Point Health Campus-Anderson. He was born May 11, 1912 in Campbell Co, Kentucky, and resided in Anderson, Indiana. He was trained in modern Quality Control engineering techniques by the War Production Board in 1944 and was instrumental in bringing quality to many industries in addition to Delco Remy, his employer of 41 years. As a past president of the American Society for Quality Control, he was a Founding Member and Fellow. In 1974 he represented the United States in a meeting of the International Standards Organization ISO at the The Hague. His many published articles and papers brought him national recognition, including the prestigious Edwards Medal awarded by ASQC. In 1996 he was honored as one of the 53 Pioneers in Quality Control. His associations included: Alpha Tau Omega Fraternity Purdue, a life member of the Society of Automotive Engineers SAE, "Silver Foxes" of the First Presbyterian Church, The Delco Remy Fellowship Club and the Purdue Club. He was a past member of the Edgewood Country Club, the Anderson Country Club and the Chamber of Commerce. He is survived by his Daughter Ruth Moeller of Sylvania, OH, Son Dr. Paul A. Bender of Jeffersonville and son Red Bender of Atlanta GA. Grandchildren include Craig Moeller, of Livonia, MI, Scott Moeller of Newman, GA, and Diane Moeller of Toledo, OH. Sister-in-law Florence Carter is a resident of Indianapolis. Five Great Grandchildren also survive him. He was preceded by his Parents Helen Knittle and Arthur Bender Sr. Wife of 54 years Martha Bender who passed

away in 1990. Services will be Wednesday January 29, 2003 at 10:30 AM, at First Presbyterian Church, Anderson, with Rev. Rick Kimmer officiating. Visitation will be from 3pm-8pm on Tuesday January 28, 2003 at Robert Loose Funeral Home, South Chapel.
