Anderson - Barbara D. Dunn Hunter, 69, Anderson, died April 1, 2005 at Puerto Vallarta, Mexico. She was born October 16, 1935 in New York City, New York, and was a lifelong Anderson resident. She was a teacher at Sacred Heart High School in Indianapolis and an Eastside Middle School math teacher. She was the local coordinator for the Rainbows for all God's Children, member of Indiana Retired Teachers Association, past chairman of St. Mary's Council of Ministries. Hunter; two children, Frank & wife Beth Hunter of El Paso, Texas and Mary Beth & husband George West of Franklin, Massachusetts and three grandchildren, Amanda Hunter, Kate West and Jill West.
