August 18, 1942 - June 29, 2025

Betty Lucille Beaty, 82, of Anderson went to her heavenly home late Sunday evening June 29, 2025, at Community Hospital following a brief illness. The daughter of George C. and Alice Alverda (Moss) Burns was born on August 18, 1942, in Walla Walla, Washington. Betty lived nearly all her life in Anderson after the family moved here when she was a young child. Betty graduated from Madison Heights High School in 1960. 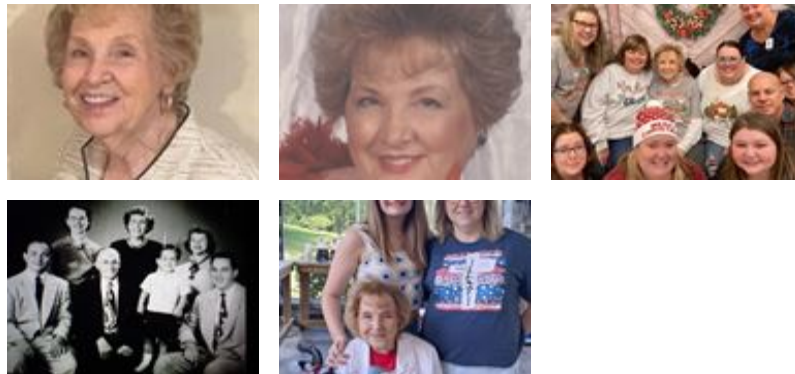
