Mrs. Beulah “Bootie” Lucille (Dutro) Hall, at the age of 98, departed this life on Saturday June 6th, and now rests in the arms of our Heavenly Father.

She was born February 20, 1922, to James Acil and Mona Jane (Smith) Dutro, near Petersburg, Indiana. 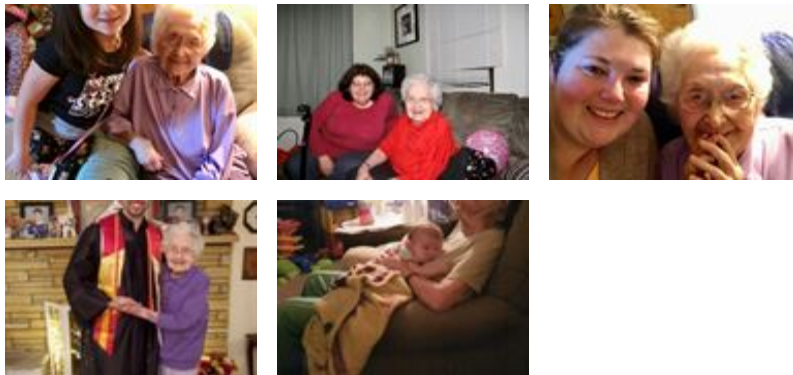
