She was preceded in death by her first husband, William A. Buell whom she married on October 18, 1962; and her parents, William E. and Jinnie Inez Barnes.

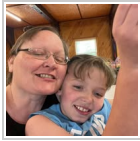

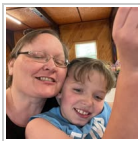

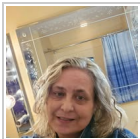
