Brenda S. Shanafelt, Anderson, died on July 19th, 2025 after battling liver cancer. She was born on December 19, 1956 in New Castle, Indiana, the first child of Donald and Charlotte Stewart. Her parents pre-deceased her in 2013. Brenda spent her early years in New Castle, then Anderson. She started elementary school in Pendleton, graduating with pride with the PHHS Class of 1975. Brenda started piano lessons when she was in 2nd grade, and took them for 5 years. While in high school, she enjoyed acting in plays and singing with the Pendletones.

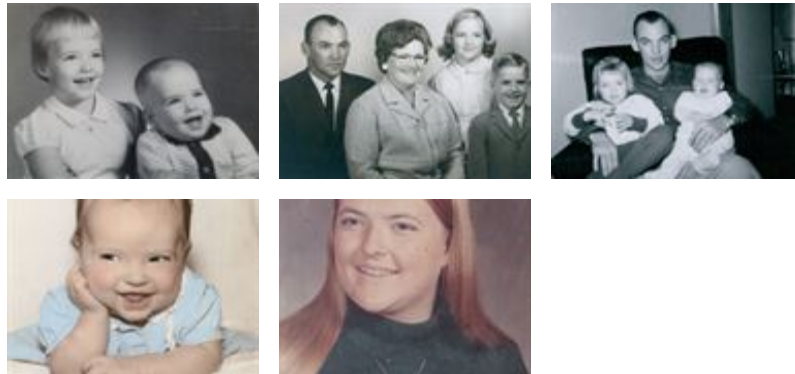

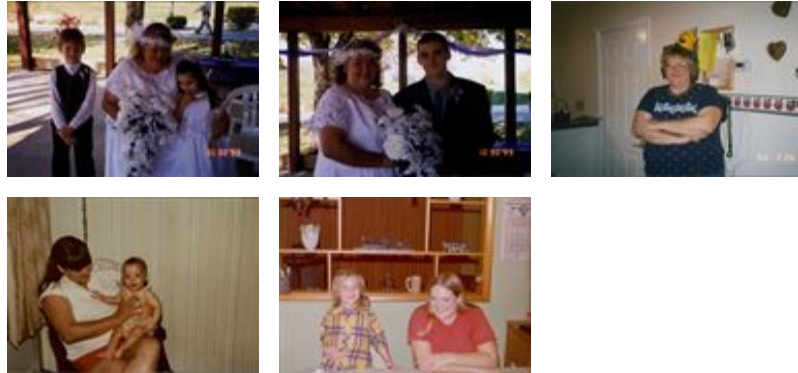
