Brian Ford Madison, 72, born November 14, 1953, in Indianapolis, Indiana, to Harry G. Madison and Lois Ford Madison, passed away on January 26, 2026. Brian loved spending time with his grandchildren, especially teaching them how to fix things and work on home improvement projects. He enjoyed the outdoors, hiking Indiana's state parks, with special fondness for Mounds State Park and McCormick's Creek, where he spent many Thanksgivings with family. Brian and his wife, Cheryl, were married for 45 years, and nearly every weekend they visited a state park together. He also loved nature preserves and planting flowers to attract birds and butterflies, particularly goldfinches and monarchs.
