Bruce Tullis of Anderson, IN, passed away on December 19th, 2020, after a short illness. He was 86 years old.

A lifelong Hoosier, Bruce was an MP in the United States Army, proudly serving in Zirndorf, Germany in the late 1950s. There he met his future wife, Frieda Wittman. They wed in 1965 and were married for nearly 50 years, until her passing in 2012.

After his service, he worked as an auto mechanic and "body man", as classic cars were his passion. He managed the Devonshire Sunoco in Anderson for several years before striking out on his own, buying, repairing, selling, and trading cars from his property on the south side of town for the rest of his days.

Bruce enjoyed fried green tomatoes, making popcorn on the stove top, watching boxing, Swisher Sweets cigars, and most of all, playing shuffleboard, at which he was naturally gifted (but ONLY if there was money on the table - no friendly games for Bruce, thank you very much!).

A quiet, independent, self-sufficient man, Bruce provided for his family with his hands and his skill and lived by example. He taught his family the meaning of compassion towards those less fortunate than ourselves, to appreciate the

simplicity of life, and to be grateful no matter what circumstances occur in that life.

He is survived by his sons Eric Tullis of Franklin and Scott Tullis of Indianapolis. He is also survived by two grandchildren, Joshua and Olivia Tullis of Franklin. We love you, Dad. You will be sorely missed.
