Anderson - Carol G. Robbins Schmidt, 85, Anderson, died Tuesday, April 20, 2010 after a brief illness. She was born October 19, 1924 in Yankton, South Dakota. After living most of her life in the state of Washington, she moved to Anderson in 2004. Survivors include a son, Roger LaDonna of Portland, Oregon; a daughter, Fran Merle Strege of Anderson; daughter-in-law, Leslie Schmidt of Ridgefield, Washington, seven grandchildren and fifteen great-grandchildren. Mrs. Schmidt was preceded in death by her husband, Vernon; parents, one brother, two sisters and daughter, Conni. Carol Robbins married Vernon F. Schmidt on July 29, 1941. For most of her adult life, she resided in Vancouver, Washington. She was devoted to her family, church and an enthusiastic traveler. She enjoyed numerous vacation trips across western Canada and Alaska as well as tours of Israel and Europe. Carol was faithful member of First Church of God in Vancouver, where she played several leadership roles. She founded and directed Peter Pan Daycare Center as a ministry of the church. Also for many years she served as executive assistant to the church's senior minister. Upon retirement she and her husband moved to Anderson Island in Puget Sound. After his death she remained on the island an active member of its retirement association until moving to Anderson to live near her daughter. Carol's life will be remembered and celebrated in a worship service to be held Saturday, May 1, 2010 at 5:00pm in Miller Chapel of the School of Theology at Anderson University.
