Carolyn was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother. She is survived by her loving spouse, Orville Slack, whom she married September 5, 1953, sons and their spouses, Dennis (Esther) Slack, Darrell (Shelly) Slack, Douglas (Lori) Slack, eleven grand-children and nine great grand-children, sister-in-law, June DeShon.

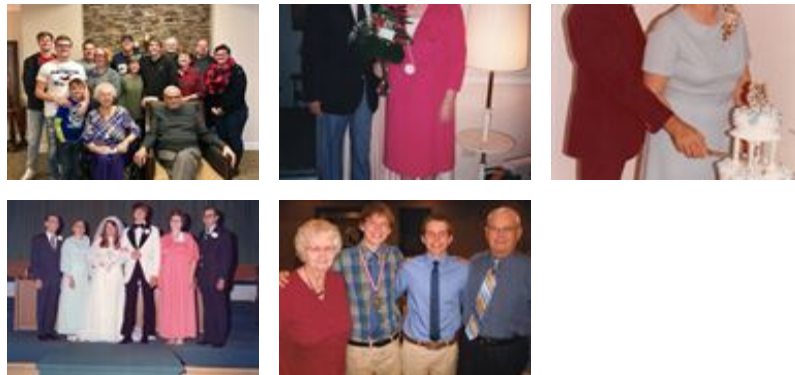
