Anderson - Charles C. Dunmire, 78, Anderson, died May 29, 2005 at Ball Memorial Hospital-Muncie after a sudden illness. He was born March 24, 1927 in Rossiter, Pennsylvania, and was an Anderson resident since 1947. He started as a Fireman on the steam engines and earned the title of Locomotive Railroad Engineer working for New York Central, Penn Central and Conrail, retiring in 1989 after 37 years of service.
