October 21, 1921 - December 1, 2005

Anderson - Crist A. Blassaras, 84, Anderson, died December 1, 2005 at Manor Care, Anderson after an extended illness. He was born October 21, 1921 in Anderson, Indiana, and resided in Anderson, Indiana all of his life. He was the son of Andrew & Foto Panos Blassaras who were both born in Corinth, Greece. He graduated from Anderson High School in 1939, from Indiana University in 1943 and Indiana University School of Medicine in 1946. He served his internship in 1946 and 1947 at Indiana University Medical Center. Dr. Blassaras began his practice on Broadway Street in 1947. He was a member of the hospital staff at St. Johns Hospital from 1947-1960 and a member of the hospital staff at Community Hospital from 1960-1990. He was named chief of Community Hospital Staff in 1976 and in 1996 earned the Certificate of Distinction for 50 years of medical practice. He was also the team doctor for the Anderson High School Basketball Team. He was a member of Trinity Episcopal Church in Anderson, Indiana University Alumni Association, Anderson Country Club, Indiana University Varsity Club, Madison County Medical Society and Indiana State Medical Society. He is survived by his Son & Daughter-in-law: Crist C. Peggy L. Blassaras of River Forrest.
