Daniel Lee Sellers, 83, of Anderson, passed away on February 8, 2026. He was born on January 24, 1943, in Cincinnati, Ohio, and resided in Anderson for the past 40 years.

Daniel graduated from Cincinnati Bible College. He served his country in the United States Navy between 1961-1964. Dan served on President Kennedy's flagship, the USS Northampton, as a diesel engineer, including during the Cuban Missile Crisis. After his love for the Lord, wife, and family, he loved the Navy.

Dan retired in 2011 from American Welding, a company he founded and ran for over 30 years.

He was a member of the East Side Church of God.

Daniel is survived by his loving spouse of 47 and a half years, Bobbi Sellers; his five children, Mechelle (Phillip Maynard) Saadawi, Mitsy (David) Croy, Marty (Robert) Parker, Joe Sellers and D. T. Sellers. He also leaves behind twelve grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Charlena McCarthy, who passed away in 2009.

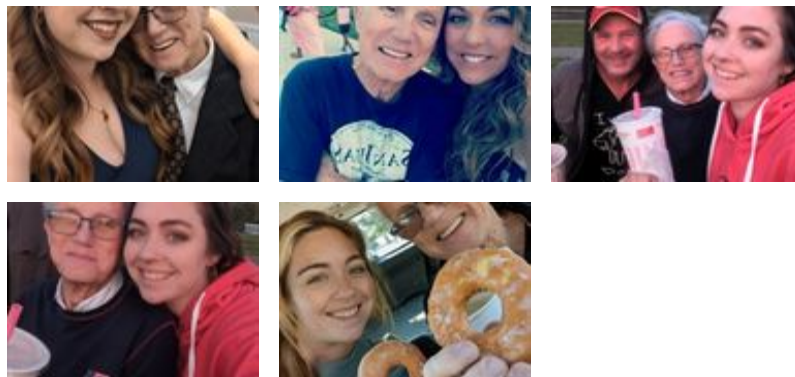

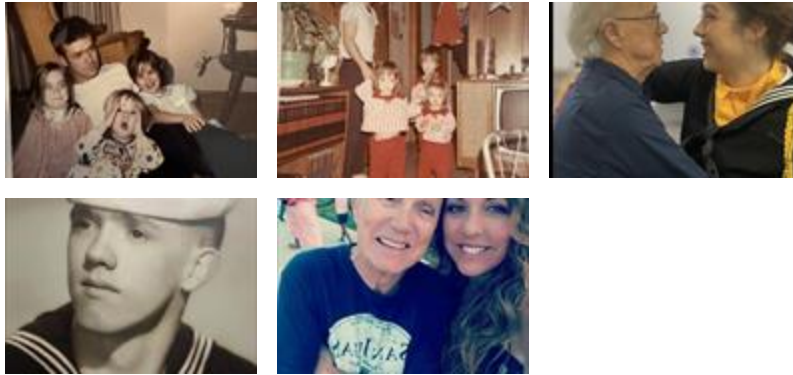

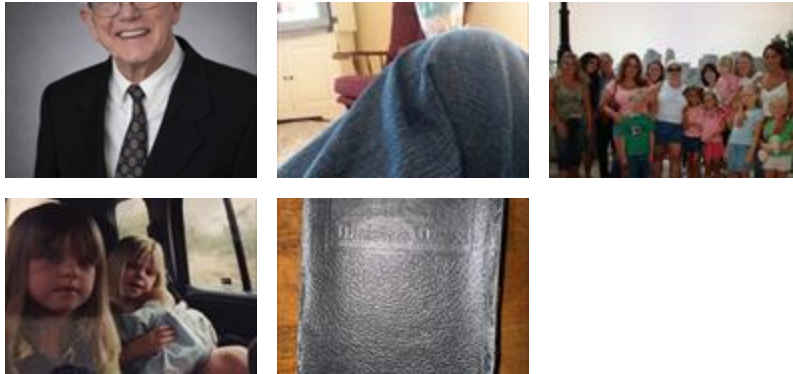
