David Alan "Dave" Pike, 76, of Anderson, passed away on August 31, 2022, in Anderson. He was born on June 23, 1946, the son of Loren "Bud" and Norma Jean "Jeanne" Pike.

David was a 1964 graduate of Highland High School. He then attended Ball State University where he received his Bachelor of Arts degree in 1968 and his Master of Arts in Education in 1972.

David retired from Anderson Community Schools after 43 years of teaching elementary and middle school. For many years he taught adult education, GT, and ELL. Following his retirement, David worked at Belgian Horse Winery.

He loved nature, hiking, kayaking, and jogging, and enjoyed working with plants and flowers. David and his wife also were world travelers.

David and his wife worked with the youth at South Meridian Church of God for many years and later attended Madison Park Church of God.

He was preceded in death by his father.

David is survived by his wife of 52 years, Joyce (Franklin) Pike; his children, Derek Pike (Kendra), Leesburg, IN, and Kortney Zagorski (Jason), Lewisville,

NC; his grandchildren, Adrianna, Eli, Hayden, and Ethan; his mother, Jeanne Pike; his brother, Rick Pike (Dianne); his sister, Dawn Truex (Toby); his brother-in-law, Mike Franklin (Susie); and several nieces and nephews.

It was David's wish not to have a funeral, but to have a celebration of his life, which will be scheduled at a later date.
