Donald Wayne Taylor, age 81, Anderson, IN went home to be with the Lord on February 2, 2017 following an extended illness. 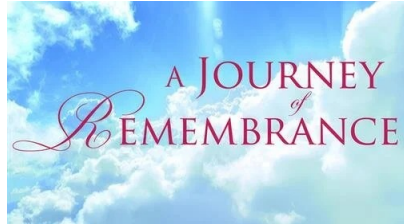
