Anderson – Dr. Russell Owen Burger Jr. D.V.M., 68, Anderson, died April 25, 2011 at his residence after an extended illness. He was born April 21, 1943 in Indianapolis, and resided in Anderson for most of his life. He was a graduate of Purdue University, where he received his Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine. Dr. Burger was a veterinarian and owner of Westsdie Veterinary Clinic. Survivors include his daughters, Laura Burger and Lisa Burger Delaplane, both of Anderson; sisters, Cathy Privette and Margaret Burger; two grandchildren, Brenden Delaplane and Corbin Burger and one granddaughter on the way. Also surviving are several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his wife, whom he married June 18, 1966, Linda Bower Burger, on October 13, 2009, and his parents, Russell Burger Sr. and Mary Tegeler Burger.
