Edward L. "Ed" Ogle, 92, of Middletown, passed away on July 28, 2022. He was born on December 16, 1929, in Detroit, Michigan, and resided most of his life in Middletown.

Ed graduated from Rochester High School.

He served his country in the United States Army during the Koran War, and in 2016 got to participate in the Indy Honor Flight to Washington D.C.

Ed worked in skilled trades for the Delco-Remy Division of General Motors and retired in 1992 after 30 years of service.

He was an avid collector and restorer of antique automobiles. He was a member of the Model T, Model A, and Central Indiana Old Car Club.

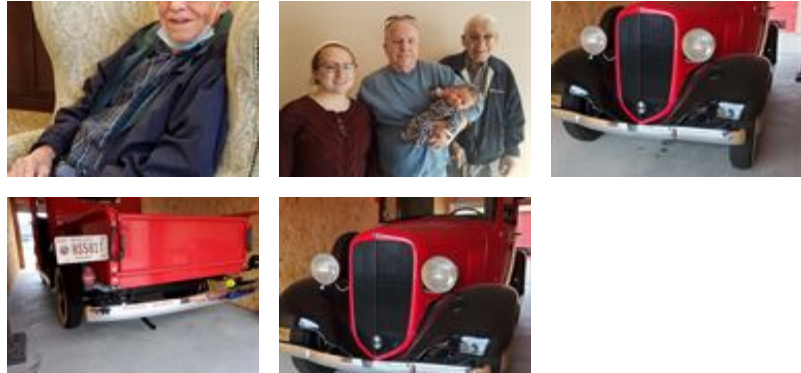
