August 13, 1943 - August 22, 2010

Anderson - Edwin Royce "Ed" Wallace, 67, Anderson, died August 22, 2010 at Rawlins House, Pendleton unexpectedly after an extended illness. He was born August 13, 1943 in Summer Shade, Kentucky, and resided in Pendleton, Indiana. A graduate of Madison Heights High School in 1962; Ed served with the U.S. Army in Vietnam. He was awarded a National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal and Vietnam Campaign Medal. He worked at Dukes until 1976 while also working at Delco Remy Division of General Motors until his retirement in 1995, after 31 years of service. After retiring, he worked part-time at Nuce's Marathon until his massive stroke on June 16, 1997. A member of U.A.W. Local #662, he enjoyed spending time with family, fishing, Nascar, and collecting keychains. He is survived by his wife of 39 years, Cathy Reeder Wallace; four children, Misty Steve Asbury of Pendleton, Jason Mandy Wallace of Markleville, Lisa Steve Fulk of Markleville & Matt Wallace of Anderson; eight grandchildren, Ashton & Allison Asbury, Justin, Chase & Alyssa Wallace and Landon, Braydon & Colton Fulk; twin sister, Joyce Gary Idlewine; brother, Bill Linda Wallace; brother-in-law, Duane Darlene Reeder; two sisters-in-law, Pam Phil Riggs and Sharon Marvin Reed; and several nieces and nephews.
