Farrell Dearman Ross, 89, of Phoenix, AZ, passed away peacefully in his sleep in Tucson, AZ on November 7, 2014.

Farrell was born in Anderson, IN on August 1, 1925. He graduated from Anderson High School in 1943. Farrell enlisted in the Army in 1946 and served until 1951. While deployed in Japan, he met his future wife, Tsugiko Okuwa. They wed on June 12, 1955 in Kobe, Japan and were married for 59 wonderful years.

Farrell worked as a production/assembly worker at the Delco Remy Division of General Motors in Anderson, IN. During that time, he also managed Maplewood Cemetery for 20 years. After retiring from General Motors, Farrell and Tsugiko moved to Phoenix, AZ, where they managed the 10th Street Palms Apartments for several years. Farrell also worked at Big Lots before health issues forced him into retirement.
