A Celebration of life will be held at a later date.

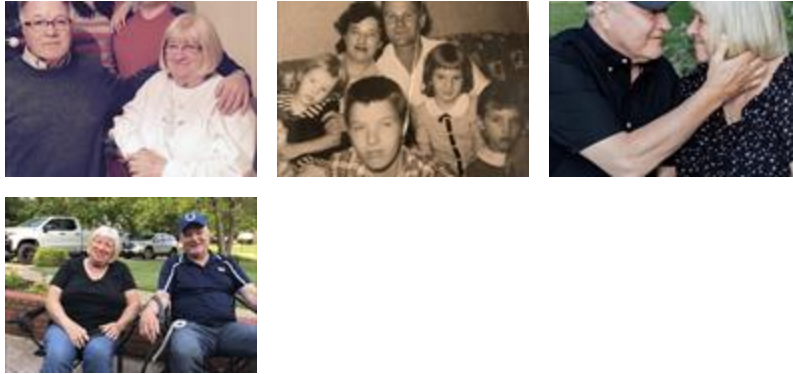
