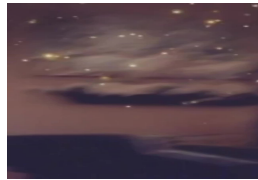


I had no idea George was ill. I worked with him at IPT & lived down the road. Him & Cathy were a great couple. I hate to see this...RIP George.

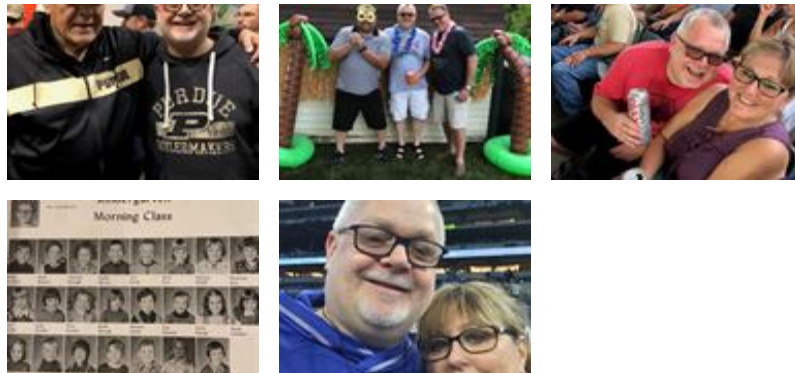

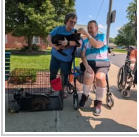
