Georgia A. Bingman Holden, 97, a longtime resident of Anderson, completed her journey to the kingdom of God on Saturday January 25, 2025, at Bethany Pointe.

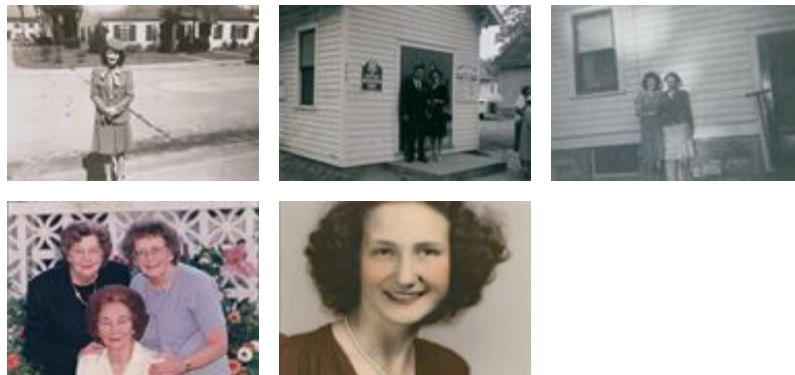
