



Gerald E. "Jerry" Rigsby

November 14, 1934 - March 28, 2020

Gerald E. Rigsby (Jerry) was born in Anderson, Indiana, on November 14, 1934, and passed away peacefully on March 28, 2020.

He graduated from Dunkirk High School in Dunkirk, IN in 1952 and the University of Notre Dame in 1956. At Notre Dame he was in the Marching Band, the Concert Band and the Varsity Band. He worked at Delco Remy Division of General Motors from June, 1956 until retirement in September, 1992. He was the Chief Engineer for Ignition Systems, Motors, Generators, Switches, Sensors and Controls. He authored the chapter on "Automotive Electrical Systems" in the 1966 edition of the McGraw-Hill Standard Handbook for Electrical Engineers as well as SAE papers on Automotive Ignition Systems. He was also awarded a US Patent for Time Delay Automotive Headlight systems,

He is survived by his wife Jane Rolfe Rigsby, whom he married on June 9, 1956; sons, Thomas (Robin) of Dublin, OH, Joseph (Sandy) of West Bloomfield, MI and John (Carla) of Pendleton and daughters, Mary (Neal) Kirby of Anderson and Ann (Michael) Oddi of The Villages, FL.
