She spent two years serving with the Peace Corp in Samoa. She was the first ever woman recorded to climb Mount Sili Sili in Western Samoa. While in Germany, she taught math on an Army Base.

She had many interests. Photography, collecting photos and memorabilia, attending reenactments, and visiting battle sites. She traveled all over the United States and had been to every state except Washington and Alaska. But best of all, she enjoyed floating over the countryside in her very own hot air balloon.

She volunteered for several years at the Madison County Humane Society. Was an animal lover and at various times shared her own home with a number of cats, dogs, a pony and a goat.

She also made part of her property into a Wetlands Preservation site.

She was a good, loving, generous person and was well liked by everyone. She will be greatly missed by her Aunt Susanne Cooper Sokol and by her numerous cousins and Friends.
