Gregory taught math eight years at Bell Gardens High School in Bell Gardens, California and was well liked by his students. He was a 1973 graduate of Madison Heights High School and a 1978 graduate of Purdue University with a degree in Industrial Engineering. He earned his MBA from University of Texas Austin in 1980. He graduated Cum Laude from Texas Tech Law School. He was a member of Delta Tau Delta fraternity from Purdue University. He is survived by his mother, Nelma L. Cox Berry-Hostetler of Anderson; aunts and uncles, Donald E. Cox & wife Mary of Elwood, Phil & wife Jan Berry of Wheaton, Illinois and Myrna Berry of Marion; and several cousins.
