Harold LeRoy Amick, 94 of Anderson and passed away May 9, 2017 at Miller's Merry Manor in Chesterfield. He was born to Andrew Wesley Amick and Betsy Mae (Williams) Amick in Bronson, Ia. 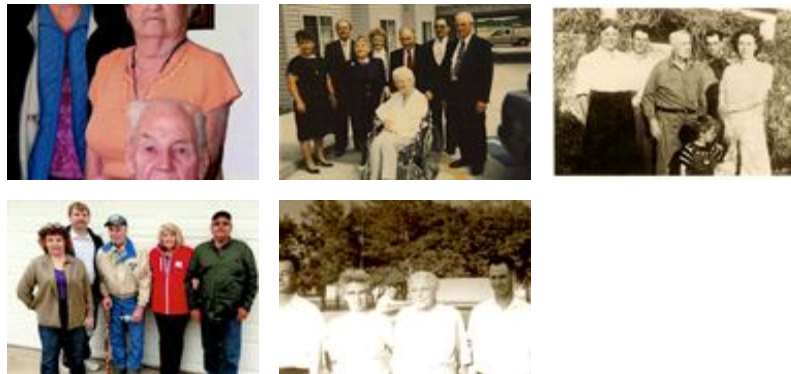
