

Harold "Pete" Corbin

March 17, 1922 - June 3, 2022

Harold "Pete" Corbin, 100, Anderson, passed away on June 2, 2022. He was born on March 17, 1922 in Canton, MO to James and Sylvia Corbin.

Pete served in the Army Air Corps in WW II, serving in the China, Burma, India Theater. He was involved in operating some of the first instrument landing systems.

He worked for Universal Electric for 25 years. Pete was also an instructor for factory laborers who had been laid off, helping them find new jobs.

Pete was a member of Toastmasters, where he served as a District Governor in the late 1970's. Pete also had perfect attendance with the Anderson Noon Lions Club for many years. He was also a long-time member of Edgewood Country Club. He was a Registered Parliamentarian. Pete also was a lifetime member of the V.F.W. and American Legion.

He was a HAM radio operator (KC9ORK).

Pete was preceded in death by his wife of 68 years, Gracie Corbin, on December 4, 2016. He was also preceded in death by his parents and his siblings, Pearl Clevestine, Lucille Wagner, Marie Collett, and Seth Corbin.

He is survived by his children, Kathryn "KC" Corbin (Frank Hughes), and Michael Corbin; his granddaughter, Kara Corbin; and numerous nieces and nephews.

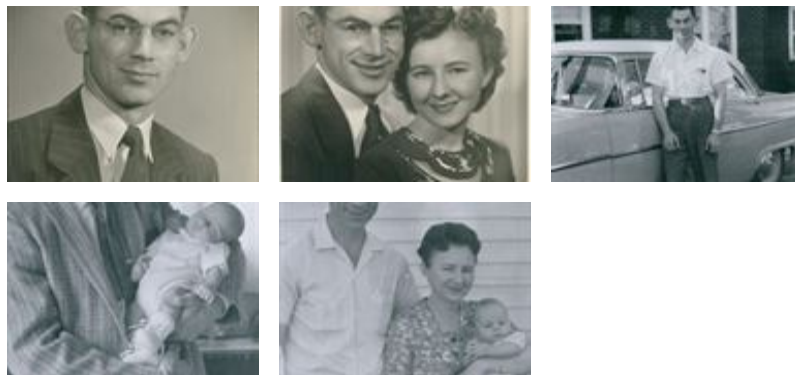
