



## Hazel M. Stamm

Hazel M. Stamm, 90, of Anderson, passed away on July 11, 2014 at Community Hospital, Anderson, IN. She passed away after a brief illness.

daughters and sisters. She started her collection of Gravy Boats in 1970. She had over 600 with only five duplicates.
