Indianapolis ? Beloved Mother and Grandmother Hilda H. Rudolph Wendling, 77, passed away on February 8, 2007 at the Castleton Health Care Center in Indianapolis after a brave battle with cancer. Born in Mannheim, Germany on November 5, 1929, Hilda immigrated to Anderson, Indiana, with her husband and infant daughter in January 1957 and became a U.S. citizen in 1965. She was a dedicated homemaker and a member of the Middletown United Methodist Church. An active member of the Indianapolis German Club, she also sang with the German Saenger-Chor. Survivors include her son, Robert Thomas Wendling wife Tracy of Pendleton, daughter, Monica Wendling Cooper husband Bill of Madison, Georgia; three grandchildren of whom she was so proud--Brian Michael Pring of Anderson and Ashlyn and Kelsee Wendling of Pendleton, and several nieces and nephews, both in Anderson and in Germany. Preceding her in death were her parents, August and Anna Rudolph of Germany, her sister Irma Moore of Texas, and her former husband of 44 years, Tom O. Wendling.
