Hugh D. Dotson passed away after a long battle with cancer. He was born in Dunham, KY and moved to Anderson, IN with his parents, Dewey Franklin and Betty Dotson, along with brothers, Jerry and Joe. He graduated from Anderson High School and Ball State University with a B.A. Degree in Business Administration. He entered the military as a Reservist with the 316th Chemical Group of Anderson and was honorably discharged in 1963. He began his career with Firestone Industrial Products of Noblesville as a sales trainee and later as a salesman for the State of Indiana. He resigned that position in 1965 to join the Hysol Corp., based in Olean, NY and City of Industry in California. He was a member and past president of the University club of Anderson. He was also a member of Society of Automotive Engineers and a board member of the EEIC Electrical and Electronic Conference. In 1973, Hysol was sold to the Dexter Corp. of Windsor Locks CT.
