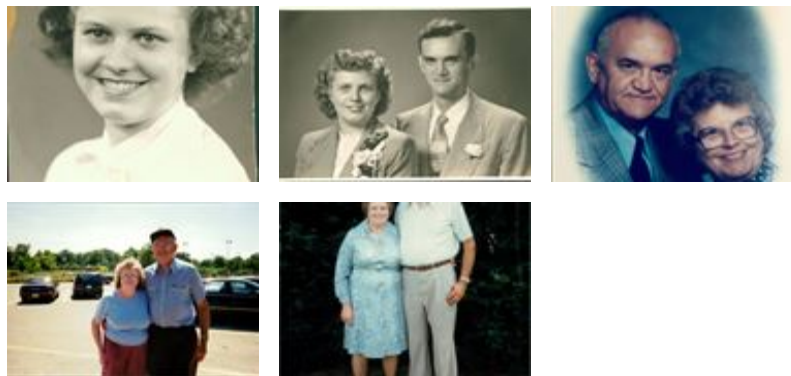


“ *To Nancy and David,
