Jeffrey Lee Moore, 70, passed away Sunday, April 19, 2026, at Community Hospital in Anderson, Indiana. A five-year struggle with cancer ended when serious pneumonia ultimately took his life. He passed away peacefully, with family present and without pain or distress.
