



## Jimmie L. Vorhees

November 9, 1944 - March 13, 2018

Jimmie L. Vorhees, 73, of Anderson, passed away on March 13, 2018 at IU Health Methodist Hospital after an extended illness. He was born on November 9, 1944 in Muncie, and resided most of his life in Anderson.

Jimmie graduated from Cowan High School in 1962, where he played basketball, baseball, and ran cross country.

He met and married the love his life, Susan Keesling, in 1972. They were married for 45 wonderful years.

Jimmie worked for Pepsi Cola (RKO Bottlers) for 18 years. He obtained his associate's degree in Computer Operations in May of 1990 . Jimmie then worked for Indiana Farmers Mutual Insurance Co., and retired in 2009. He spent his "retirement" working at Pet Supplies Plus in Noblesville, where he loved every second of interacting with customers-two legged and four legged.

Jimmie was inducted into the Indiana Softball Hall of Fame in 2009 for playing softball for the Anderson Astros. His favorite pastime was spending time with his family. He loved playing the card game "21" with his mom and sister, and was a huge Colts, NASCAR, and racing fan. He enjoyed going to many local races with his son, Jimmie, his brother, Bud, and his best friend and son-in-law, Tom.

He is also survived by his 93 year young mother, Della Vorhees of Muncie; older brother, Harrold "Bud" (June) Vorhees; several nieces, nephews, cousins; best bud, Wally, his 11 year old rescue pit-mix, and Lula Belle, a rescued three-legged miniature poodle (age unknown).

He was preceded in death by his father, Virgil Vorhees; and sisters, Cynthia Ann Vorhees and Cynthianna Sturgeon.

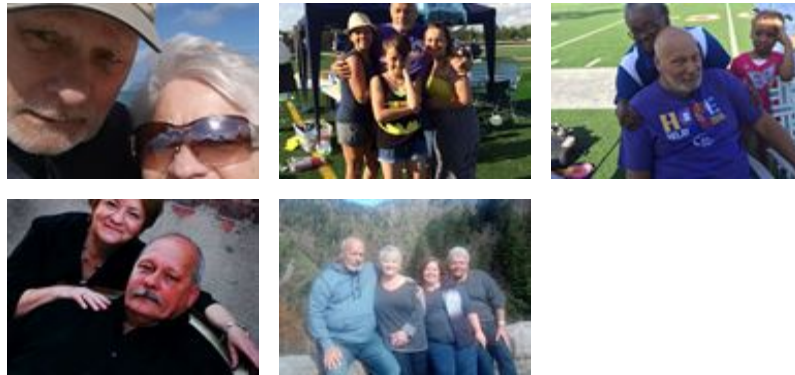
