Anderson - John M. Chaille, 88, Anderson, died October 19, 2007 at Community Hospital, Anderson after a brief illness. He was born February 12, 1919 in Ft. Branch, Indiana, and had lived in Anderson since 1950. John was Vice President and General Manager of Emge Packing Company from 1950-1982. He served his country with the U.S. Army.
