



## John Lee Kimmerling

May 20, 1945 - June 6, 2024

John Lee Kimmerling, of McCordsville, IN, passed away on June 6, 2024, at New York Presbyterian/Columbia University Medical Center in Manhattan at the age of 79.

He was born May 20, 1945, in Anderson, IN, to John Wilbur Kimmerling and Eilene (Bucy) Kimmerling. He graduated from Highland High School in Anderson in 1963 and from GMI Institute (Kettering University) in 1968 with a degree in Mechanical Engineering.
