John Hayden Maidlow, 64, Anderson, suddenly passed away at his residence in Michigan on Thursday, January 21st, 2021.

He was born on Tuesday, June 5th, 1956, in Muncie, Indiana to James W. and Evelyn M. (Lehman) Maidlow.

His legacy lives on in the hearts of his wife of 43 years, Susann L. (Hepler) Maidlow, 66; daughter, Kathryn (Katie) C. After a long day at work, he enjoyed coming home to his wife, daughter, and three furry, four-legged boys. John spent his evenings relaxing on his property, delighting in God's creation and planning for his future retirement.

John is dearly loved and will be immensely missed.
