Joseph "Joe" L. Holding, 88, of Anderson, passed away May 3, 2016 after a brief illness. He was born July 30, 1927 in Greenfield, Indiana and resided most of his life in Anderson.

Joe graduated from Anderson High School, Class of 1945. He served his country in the US Army Constabulary during the post World War II occupation of Germany from 1945-1947.

He retired in 1988 as an Engineer for Guide Lamp Division of General Motors with 32 years of service.

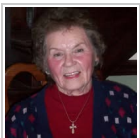
