



## Kadence Rene LaPole

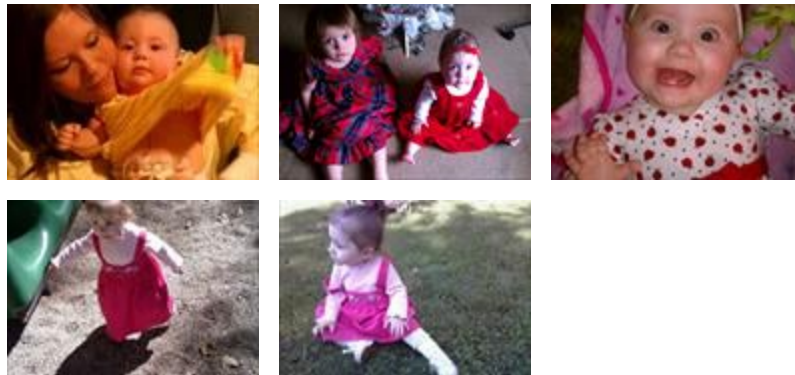
January 16, 2011 - April 19, 2013
