



## Larry W. Holloway

June 4, 1935 - July 8, 2007

Markleville - Larry W. Holloway, 72, Markleville, died July 8, 2007 at St. Johns Health System, Anderson Indiana after a brief illness. He was born June 4, 1935 in Anderson and was a lifelong resident of Madison County A farmer, he retired from Delco Remy after 37 1/2 years of service. He graduated from Markleville High School in 1954. Larry attended Pendleton New Life Wesleyan Church and was a member of the U.A.W. Local #662. He coached Anderson University Softball for 30 years, 24 years as head coach and 6 years as the assistant coach. He was the founder of the Pendleton Girls Softball program working with them from 1973 - 1981 where he was a past president. He was one of the founders of the Pendleton Jr. Football program, and also worked with Pendleton Jr. Baseball and Babe Ruth. He enjoyed collecting coins and baseball cards.
