Anderson - Lee B. Imel, 100, Anderson, died April 1, 2006 at Bethany Pointe Health Campus-Anderson after extended illness. He was born March 21, 1906 in Madison County, Indiana, and resided in Anderson, Indiana. He was a lifelong Madison County resident.
