



Linda Jean Roudebush

December 24, 1940 - July 31, 2025

Linda Jean (Griffin) Roudebush, 84, was born on a snowy Christmas Eve in 1940 to Thomas and Neva (McMullen) Griffin. The last surviving among her siblings, Linda spent the majority of her life in Anderson, Indiana, surrounded by family and friends.

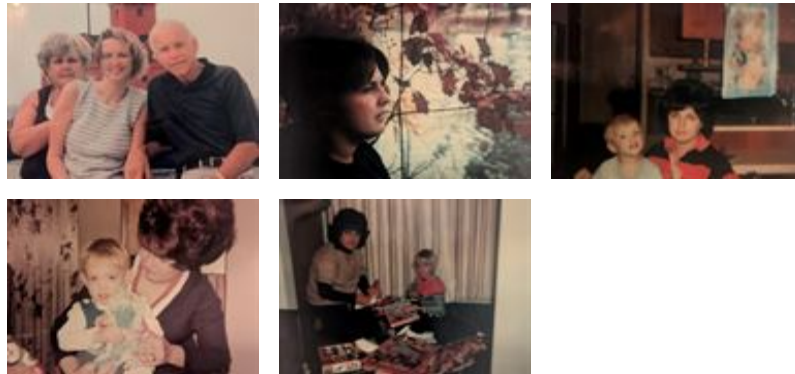

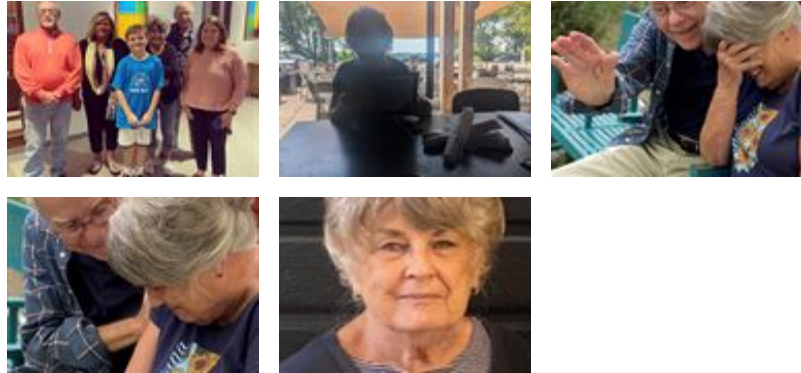
