December 12, 1960 - April 25, 2006

Anderson - Lori Lyn Hite Callender, 45, Anderson, went home to be with her Heavenly Father on April 25, 2006 after a four year battle with breast cancer. Lori was a 1979 graduate of Highland High School, where she was a varsity cheerleader and a member of the gymnastics team. She attended Ball State University, Eastside Church of God and Bible Study Fellowship at the Chesterfield Christian Church. Lori adored children and was the proud owner of "Just for Kids" daycare/preschool which was nominated for Anderson's best Day Care in 2004. She also was a coach for the Anderson YMCA gymnastics team in the early 1980s.
