



## Louis E. Moller

November 21, 1915 - May 8, 2014

Louis E. Moller, 98, of Anderson, died on May 8, 2014 at St. Vincent's Hospice Center in Indianapolis following an extended illness. He was born on November 21, 1915 in Phoenix, Arizona. After living in many cities and towns across the United States, he graduated in 1934 from Spencer High School in Spencer, Indiana. In 1941, he married Pauline Cline of Paris, Illinois. They remained together in marriage for 64 years until her death in 2005. He learned the trade of meat cutter from his father and while working for Kroger Grocery Stores. He learned sales at Kingan & Company, meat packers in Indianapolis. In 1954, while living in Delphos, Ohio, he was hired by the Emge Packing Company and in 1957 came to Anderson as a Sales Supervisor. Later, he became Assistant Sales Manager and retired in 1981 from the company after 27 years of service.
