Malcolm R. "Mac" Hall, 91, formerly of Anderson, passed away on September 12, 2014 at the Waterford Health Campus in Kokomo. He was born on July 28, 1923 in Westport, Indiana and resided most of his life in Anderson.

Mac graduated from Anderson High School, and he served his country in the Navy during WWII, where he was assigned to LST 497. His ship landed on Omaha Beach on D-Day. He continued supporting the war effort in the European Theater by crossing the English Channel 69 times transporting troops and supplies.

Mac retired from the US Postal Service, and he was a member of Solar Masonic Lodge No. 734 F. & A. M., and The Madison County Shrine Club. He enjoyed attending the Madison County Shrine Club, going to auctions trying to find a good bargain, and visiting with friends over a cup of coffee.
