November 6, 1926 - December 2, 2010

Indianapolis - Margel Bare Zukunft, 84, Sun City Center, Florida, passed away on December 2, 2010 in Indianapolis. Born in Jasonville, Indiana on November 6, 1926, she was the daughter of William Baxter and Myrtle Bare. She lived in Indiana for most of her life and had been a Sun City Center resident for 17 years. Margel graduated from Midland High School, Jasonville in 1944 and completed nursing training at the Methodist Hospital School of Nursing in Indianapolis. She was a registered nurse for 41 years and retired from Lafayette Home Hospital in Lafayette in 1989. She was a member of Unity Community Church in Sun City Center, Florida. In addition to working as a volunteer in the church office, Margel was an accomplished quilter. She was well-regarded for the creativity, quality and precision required for quilting, lending much of her knowledge and skills to other quilters. She was also an American Red Cross Disaster Services volunteer with the Tampa Bay Chapter. Survivors include two sons, Mark Zukunft of Danville, Indiana and Michael Zukunft of Indianapolis; one grandson, Douglas Zukunft; six nieces and nephews.
