Margo Boyer (nee Davis), 81, of Indianapolis, passed away on June 1, 2025, at the St. Vincent Anderson Hospital following an extended illness. She was born on March 10, 1944, at Walter Reed Hospital in Washington, DC, the daughter of William and Suzanne (Hess) Davis.

Having grown up in Middletown, Indiana, Margo graduated from Ball State University in 1966 and received her Masters degree at Butler University. She went on to a long and successful career as a Health and P.E. teacher. She taught with the Avon schools and spent 41 years teaching for the Indiana Department of Corrections at the Indiana Girls School.

Margo's cheerful attitude and quick wit won the hearts of many friends and colleagues, as she took part in school activities and social groups such as The Bag Ladies and 4H. Margo was an avid golfer and volleyball enthusiast for many years. She is fondly remembered for her performances at many functions where she played the part of Maudie Fricker, a cantankerous and funny persona who entertained the attendees. In later years, Margo had a reputation as a ruthless opponent in Farkle.

Margo is survived by her loving son, Charles (Chip) Whiting; her sister, Penny Hodson; nephews, Mark (Donna) Hodson, and Kraig Hodson; her

granddaughter, Caitlin (Josh) Laberee; and great-grandson, Owen Laberee. Margo was preceded in death by her parents.

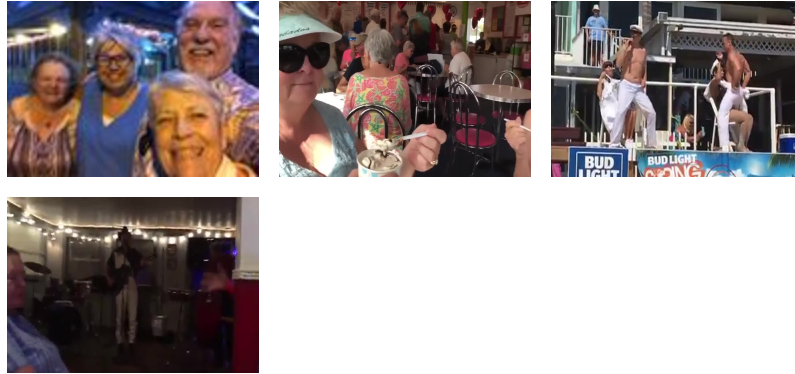
