Marilyn Jean McKean, a beautiful and much-loved wife, daughter, sister, mother, aunt, grandmother, and great-grandmother passed away on November 12, 2022, at the age of 87.

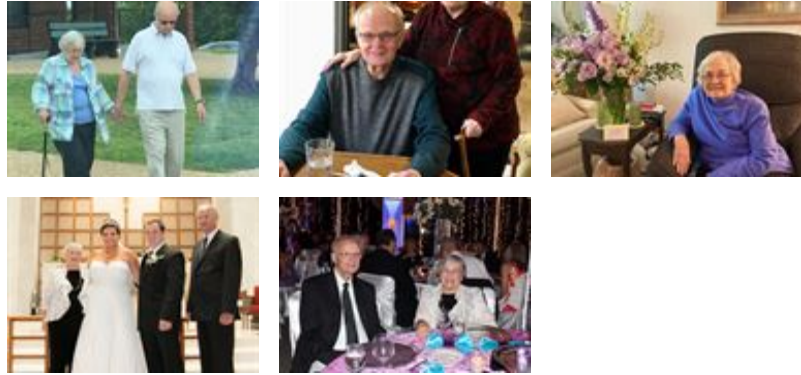
