She was preceded in death by her parents, Ralph and Evalyn Clendenen; her

sisters, Mikel Rusher and Tana Granger; her fiancé, Randy Holt Littrell; her grandparents; and many aunts, uncles, and cousins.

Dawn is survived by her daughters, Stephanie (Mark) Miller and April Adams; her grandchildren, Trystan Adams (Ashton Welte), Jesse (Sean) Johnson, Jack Adams, and Harper Adams; and her great-grandson, Carter Adams. She is also survived by her brother, Mark Clendenen (Karrie Michael); and many beloved nieces, nephews, cousins, and special friends, including Wanda Jackson, Craig Andrews, and Theresa Barber.

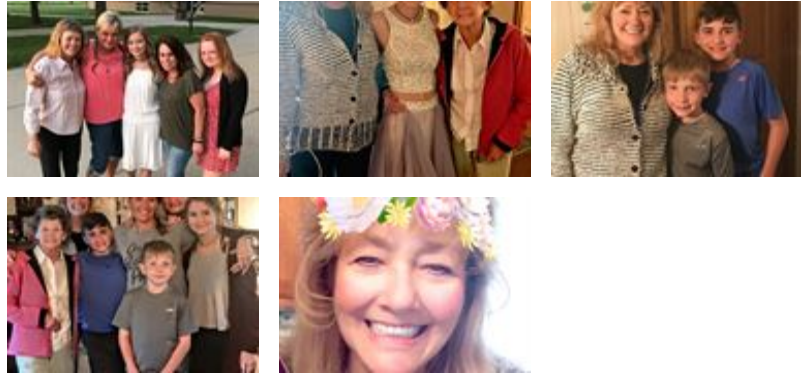
