She was President of Hank Snow Fan Club from 1954-1960 and President of the Indiana Chapter of the Marty Robbins Fan Club from 1953-1955. Survivors include her daughter, Denise Elaine Abshire, McCordsville, IN, her grand-cats, Mackenzie, Spencer & Buffy; great grandcats, Zip, Inky, Cubby, Frankie, Socks, Sally & P.; her brother, Dr. Evan K.
